

Community Relations

Visitors to the Schools

The District encourages visits by Board of Education members, parent(s)/guardian(s), citizens, and taxpayers to all School District buildings. All visitors shall report to the Building Principal's office. If a parent wishes to confer with a teacher, an appointment must be made. Conferences will be held outside school hours or during the teacher's conference/preparation period.

Any staff member may request any person entering school buildings or grounds to identify himself and the purpose of his entry. A person who refuses to provide such information is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. The Principal or his designee shall seek the immediate removal of any person who (1) refuses to provide identification or the purpose of his entry, (2) interferes with, disrupts, or threatens to disrupt any school activity or the learning environment, (3) or engages in an activity in violation of Board Policy 8.30 or 8.40.

Prohibitions

Except as provided in Policy 8.25, the Board prohibits advertising, commercial promotion, community political activity, and loitering in the schools.

Commercial/Political Activities

Except as provided in Policy 8.25, no identification of the schools with the promotion of any commercial or political enterprise will be permitted. This is not to prohibit the sponsoring or broadcasting of school-related events by commercial enterprises.
