Whiteboard + Computer = Smart Board

What enables the user to “write” in different colors with his finger, to erase by drawing a circle around what is needed to be erased and then touching the center, and to surf the net right on the whiteboard? Why, it’s a SmartBoard! A computer makes the board interactive; the board becomes a giant “monitor”.

Of course, if you only used the Smartboard as a computer monitor or whiteboard, you’d be missing all the wonderful activities which can be created using Notebook 10 software.
